

MIW Radio Group's Mary Bether Garber Wins 2008 Radio Wayne "Broadcaster of the Year" Award at RAB2008 In Atlanta

ATLANTA, GA (February 13, 2008): The 16th annual *Radio Ink* Radio Wayne Awards were presented this morning during the awards' annual breakfast presentation from the RAB conference at the Hyatt Regency Hotel in Atlanta, Georgia. Emerging from a solid group of finalists to claim this year's America's Best Broadcast trophy was Southern California Broadcasters Association President and Mentoring and Inspiring Women(MIW) Radio Group Executive Committee member, Mary Beth Garber.

Garber graciously thanked her group's executive board for the hard work that made her win in the category possible. "These people (Southern California Broadcasters Association members) prove that you can take five people from five companies and -- when they all work together -- generate a market that I am pleased to say generated over \$1 billion last year," she said.
